This Wednesday - Mountain Park Hosts Groundbreaking for New Tempe Clinic

New clinic triples capacity for affordable healthcare

Tempe, AZ – Mountain Park Health Center is breaking ground on their newest clinic this Wednesday. The 32,000 sq. ft. health clinic, located on the former property of the Skipper Bud's boat dealership, on the northeast corner of Broadway and McClintock, is scheduled to open mid-2017.

Mountain Park currently operates a clinic in the St. Luke's Hospital medical building, but patient demand has caused them to outgrow the space. The new clinic will provide nearly four times the clinic space, enabling the medical staff at Mountain Park to care for over three times the number of patients in the Tempe Community.

In addition to providing affordable primary care for the whole family with several dozen exam rooms, the new clinic will feature indoor and outdoor community space as well as sustainable design elements such as natural light, shade trees, and an extensive materials recycling project during the demolition of portions of the existing building.
